The Ascend Fund Announces Over Half a Million in Grant Funding for Pilot Initiative Focused on Electing Women to State Legislatures

Pilot to launch in Michigan, Mississippi, and Washington to accelerate gender parity in politics

SEATTLE – Today, <u>The Ascend Fund</u>, a collaborative fund dedicated to accelerating the pace of change toward gender parity in U.S. politics, announced \$540,000 in available grant funding to nonpartisan, nonprofit organizations in Michigan, Mississippi, and Washington state to increase the number of women serving in the states' legislatures.

"Critical policy decisions are made by state legislators. By investing in women, we are not just creating a more reflective democracy, we are investing in the health and stability of our political institutions," said Abbie Hodgson, Director of The Ascend Fund.

Women are more than half the population, but less than one-third of elected officials. At the current rate of change, women won't reach political parity in the U.S. for nearly 100 years. To accelerate the rate of change, organizations selected to participate in this two-year, three-state pilot will receive up to \$100,000 in funding to:

- Build state coalitions of like-minded groups that share a commitment to gender parity, racial equity, and reproductive rights.
- Identify common and unique barriers hindering women's success in reaching state elected office and develop strategies to remove, reduce, or circumvent those barriers.
- Increase the number of women running for the state legislature through targeted, coordinated, community-based recruitment.
- Provide women with the training, tools, resources, and support necessary to successfully run for the state legislature.
- Highlight women's underrepresentation and normalize women's leadership through public messaging campaigns.

"This pilot will allow us to identify common barriers women face, and test and evaluate strategies to overcome them in three very different political environments," said Hodgson. "We expect to learn invaluable lessons that will inform our approach in the other 47 states as we move towards our goal of achieving 50% representation in all 50 states by 2050."

Women trained by Ascend partners had a 70% win rate in their primaries and 62% win rate in their general elections – nearly double the national average for women candidates. The Fund is powered by Panorama.
